

Research Subjects Needed

- Title:** The role of supraspinal structures in triggering automatic postural responses
- Purpose:** This study will examine the role of the brain in maintaining balance during unexpected balance disturbances. It is known that the brain is involved in modifying balance correcting movements following a loss of balance. However, there has been little evidence to confirm whether or not the brain plays a critical role in triggering the onset of these balance reflexes.
- We are looking for healthy control subjects (19-35 years old). If you have any causes of balance or cognitive impairment you should not participate
